CNZ TC Response

CNZ does not feel that there is a current need for a National 3+ Doubles tournament. The GC Open Doubles was held in the same region a few days before this event. That event could accept up to 40 players (which is more than the Open singles limit of 32) and had plenty of vacancies, so 3+ players would have been welcome to compete in that event.
